The collaborative work that has been developing in the United Nations High Commissioner for Refugees its has been very successful because they are stretching the relations between the countries so they can look for a common good: protect and save the rights of the refugees. On the first topic of the agenda which talks about the unaccompanied refugees and migrant children was very assertive as a because the resolution UNHCR/I/1 was adopted by consensus with no objection, where countries like Germany, France, Jordan, Morocco, Peru, Turkey, United Kingdom, and the United States of America asked for the intervention of the INTERPOL for the implementation of a program for detection and localization of victim, and programs for literacy and health development in the long term for the children as well.

In the second day of debates its has been discussed the resolution UNHCR/II/2 where countries like Mexico, Thailand, Germany, France, Peru, Sudan and Turkey run as sponsors, many nations had the opportunity to negotiate tributes with which they count to give a security guarantee to the refugees. France, Peru and Germany have taken the initiative of coordinate the resources that will be offered to the refugees, among them the alimentation, the clean water and the clothing.

They emphasized the creation of a program called “Spring Board” which will take charge of offering and developing temporary shelters in order to create a safe environment for the refugees.

The delegation of Sudan commented an initiative to create a plan for those countries that are willing to help being a temporary and permanent shelter to every person who needs asylum.

The delegates mentioned that the main problem that they’re facing it’s the poverty but not just the economic one, unless the knowledge poverty, peace poverty, leadership poverty.
